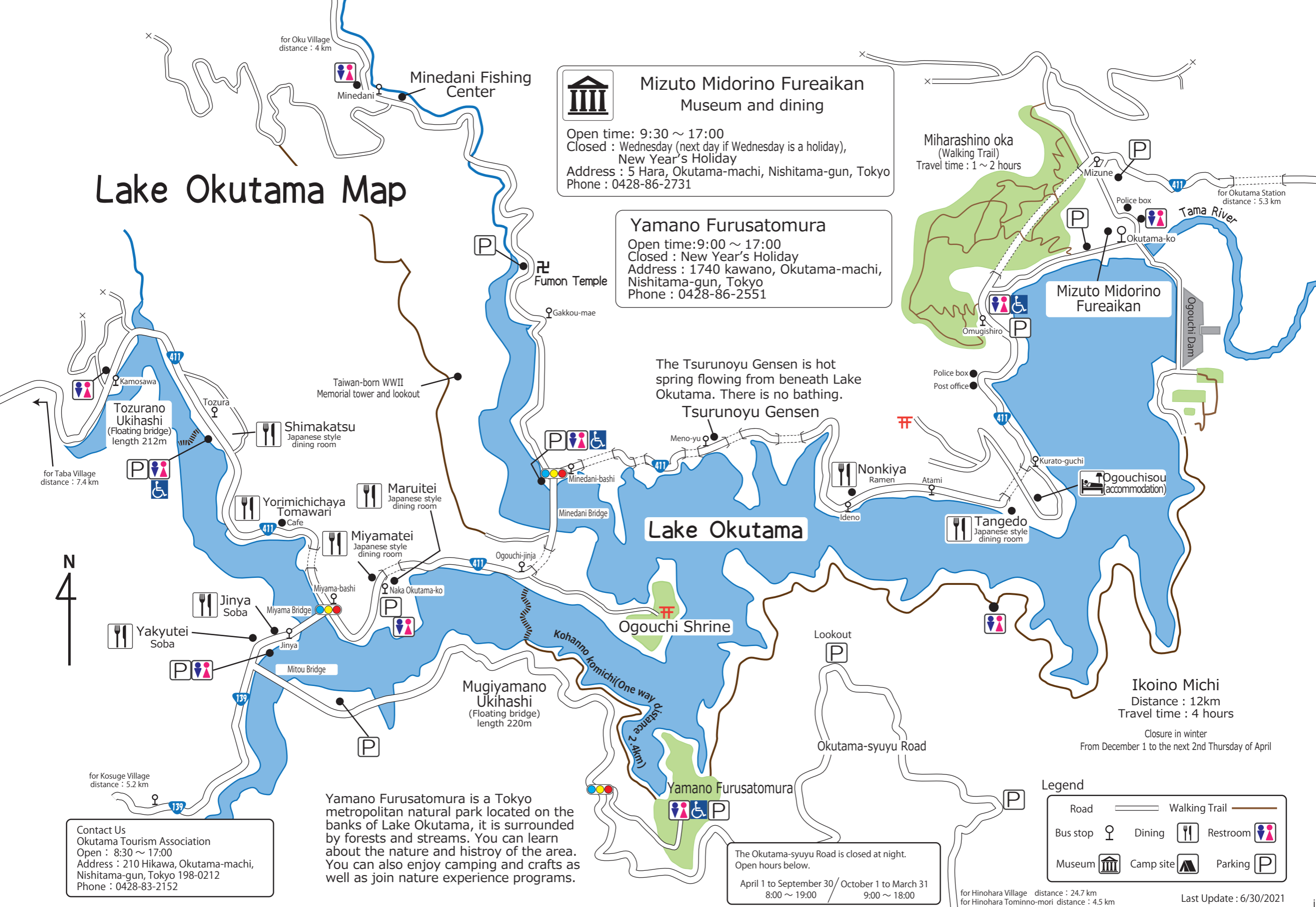


Lake Okutama Map
